Cascade Clamps - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company began as a small machine shop hiring just 4 people. Overall sales for that year amounted to about sixty thousand dollars. The first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and different components. During 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to \$330,000. At present, Cascade is one of the top worldwide makers in the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively engage in better business possibilities. Throughout the final sixty years, the industry of material handling has grown into a really advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade at present continues to develop as the leader supplier of forklift attachments and various associated items. The company feels assured in their skill so as to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the global market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, making and advertising hydraulic accessories. Construction was completed in the year 1956 on a brand new office to accommodate all of the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. After fifteen years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty workers and sales had reached almost \$2,300,000.

1959 in Springfield, Killeen the next manufacturing plant was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The company changed its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The business has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the United States with places in Springfield, Killeen, Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are made worldwide thanks to many subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and 1997 after acquiring five corporations, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the international leader in forks.
